



Multi-Year Implementation

Implementation Models

The Advisory Core Lessons curriculum is a school wide social-emotional learning system that is integrated across multiple grade levels and years. The following models allow schools to decide the best possible solution for implementation.

Schools select from the following models:

○ MODEL #1: SYNCHRONIZED MODEL

Each grade level focuses on exactly the same set of lessons at the same time over the course of a year. All teachers rotate through three sets of lessons over the course of 3 years. Students receive all 3 years of the curriculum. **Example:** In the 1st year, Grades 6, 7, & 8 implement Course 1 simultaneously. In the 2nd year, grades 6, 7, & 8 implement Course 2 simultaneously. In the 3rd year, grades 6, 7, & 8 implement Course 3 simultaneously. The cycle repeats each year.

○ MODEL #2: PROGRESSIVE MODEL

Each grade level is assigned it's own set of lessons that compliment the skills being taught throughout the school. A teacher is provided a year's worth of lessons to use year after year. Students receive all 3 years of the curriculum. **Example:** 6th grade implements Course 1. 7th Grade implements Course 2. 8th Grade implements Course 3. The cycle repeats each year.
